

ORDINANCE NO. 08-01

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A TEMPORARY LAND USE REGULATION FOR THE ENTIRETY OF THE TOWN OF HIDEOUT; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR A TERMINATION DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the town of Hideout, Utah, was recently incorporated, thus it is currently without the necessary land use regulations; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10-9a-504 of the Utah Code, Hideout has the option of adopting a temporary land use regulation to protect existing land uses and provide the Town an opportunity to assemble a planning commission and develop a code that reflects the desires of the community and the Council; and,

WHEREAS, without any regulations in place, current property owners are at risk, having no assurance regarding the use or development of neighboring parcels, thus the implementation of a temporary land use code is a compelling, countervailing interest to protect the public; and,

WHEREAS, it is arguable that the property within a newly incorporated municipality is unregulated, such a condition should not remain.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF HIDEOUT, UTAH:

SECTION I: Repealer. If any provisions of the Town's Code heretofore adopted are inconsistent herewith, they are hereby repealed.

SECTION II: Enactment. The Town Code for the Town of Hideout, Utah is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. The Wasatch County General Plan for the property within the corporate limits of Hideout is hereby adopted by reference and incorporated herein by this reference and made a part of the Town Code.
2. The Wasatch County Code, Title 16, is hereby adopted, as amended, by reference and incorporated herein by this reference and made a part of this Town Code.
3. That Sections 10-9a-601 through 10-9a-611 of the Utah Code is hereby adopted by reference and incorporated herein and made a part of this Town Code to address the development of subdivisions.
4. That the AWPAs Engineering Design Standards be adopted by reference and incorporated herein and made a part of the Town Code.
5. This Ordinance will expire on January 16, 2009, unless otherwise amended, replaced, or repealed.


SECTION IV: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be severed and such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION V: Effective Date. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizenry and public at large, this ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon posting.
