

ORDINANCE 09-06

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE TOWN OF HIDEOUT AS THE SANITARY SEWER AUTHORITY FOR THE TOWN OF HIDEOUT, UTAH

WHEREAS, the provision for the treatment of raw sewage is important to public health and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Hideout;

WHEREAS, Utah State code gives municipalities the discretion to determine the priority of development of the facilities directed toward the elimination of health hazards;

WHEREAS, Utah State code also gives municipalities the authority to serve as its own Sanitary Sewer Authority in order to determine appropriate standards for the town's sanitary sewer system, such as treatment capacity and collection capacity;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council have determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the Town to establish the Town of Hideout as its own Sanitary Sewer Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF HIDEOUT, UTAH:

SECTION I: Repealer. If any provisions of the Town's Code heretofore adopted are inconsistent herewith they are hereby repealed.

SECTION II: Enactment. That the Town Council of Hideout, Wasatch County, State of Utah, does hereby adopt the following ordinance:

- 1. SANITARY SEWER AUTHORITY – ESTABLISHMENT.** The Town of Hideout is designated to serve as the Sanitary Sewer Authority for the Town of Hideout, Utah.
- 2. BOARD AND RESPONSIBILITY.** The Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Hideout will serve as the Sanitary Sewer Authority board with the responsibility to review and approve the feasibility of sanitary sewer services or onsite wastewater systems for properties within the Town of Hideout.


The Sanitary Sewer Authority board shall:

- A. Determine the appropriate standards for the sanitary sewer system or onsite wastewater system for treatment capacity and collection capacity;
- B. Require specific information and materials necessary to complete the review and approval of the feasibility of sanitary sewer services or onsite wastewater systems.

SECTION III: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be severed and such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance.


SECTION IV: Effective Date. This ordinance, being necessary for the peace, health, safety and welfare of the town, shall become effective immediately upon posting.
