Noxious Weed Control Extended Deadline

With delayed growing conditions this spring, the reporting deadline for noxious weed control has been extended to June 14th.

Who should report? Home and land owners with dedicated lots or parcels for which they are personally responsible for landscape care. Residents that live in twin and town homes or single family homes on common property do not need to report. Their respective HOAs are responsible for weed control.
